

ALL SAINTS C OF E INFANTS SCHOOL

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is All Saints Infants School (Church of England Aided).
2. The school is a Voluntary Aided School.
3. The name of the governing body is the governing body of All Saints Infants School Church of England Aided).
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - Two parent governors
 - One LA governor
 - One staff governor
 - One headteacher
 - Seven foundation governors, of whom two shall, at the time of appointment, be eligible for election or appointment as parent governors. Foundation governors must outnumber the total of all other governors by two.
5. The total number of governors shall be twelve.
6. Of the foundation governors three are to be appointed by the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education and three are to be appointed by the Parochial Church Council of the Parish of All Saints, Reading.
7. (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio:
 - The Vicar of All Saints Church, Reading.

(b) The foundation body or person named in paragraph 7 shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose office derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
8. The Archdeacon of Berkshire shall be entitled to request the removal of the ex-officio foundation governor named in 7(a) above and to appoint a substitute foundation governor.
9. The school has a trust deed dated 23rd December 1876, and the first pupils were enrolled at the school in 1865.

10. The religious ethos of the school is as follows:

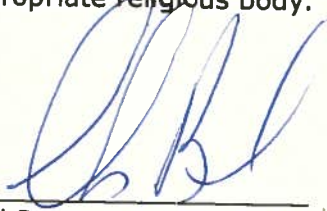
"Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England, and in partnership with the Church at Diocesan and Parish levels.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers all its pupils."

11. This instrument of government comes into effect on 24th June 2015.

12. This instrument was made by order of Reading Borough Council Local Authority on 12 June 2015

13. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the Headteacher if not a governor), any trustees, and to the appropriate religious body.
